Learning Resources

- I have a computer which I am bringing with me OR I will [purchase a computer](#) when I arrive (costs \$500-\$1500 AUD depending on the model).
- I will be required to buy textbooks/e-texts for some units, these may cost between \$15-\$100 each depending on the unit.

Living in Hobart

- I understand that the [cost of living in Hobart](#) can be between \$170-\$250 AUD per week **PLUS** \$120-\$250 rent. A total of \$290-\$500 per week.
- While part time work is allowed if it does not interfere with studies, I realise that I cannot rely on this work to support myself during my studies.
- I have organised somewhere to stay in Hobart while looking for long-term accommodation OR have booked accommodation with [UTAS accommodation services](#).
- I can use the [Metro Tas website 'trip planner'](#) to check how long it takes to catch public transport from my accommodation to the University's Sandy Bay campus.
- My [Overseas Health Cover](#) provides an online doctor's service in case I have trouble finding a doctor in Hobart.

IT Skills

- I can browse the internet and save a website to my browser's 'bookmarks'.
- I can send and receive emails in Microsoft Outlook.
- I can download attached files from emails and attach files to emails.
- I can create folders on my laptop and organise my files in them.
- I can create files in doc and pdf format.

Managing my studies

- I understand that classes run every day from Monday to Friday.
- I will attend all my classes, which will be at least 20 hours of classes per week.
- I will allow at least 10 additional hours per week for independent learning and assessment activities, in addition to class time.
- I realise that I may have limited time for a part time job outside of class time but that my studies must come first at all times. We strongly recommend that any part time work is limited to weekends and holidays.
