## PATHWAY SCHOLARSHIPS

### Foundation Connect progression scholarships

Students who have successfully progressed from the Foundation Connect programme to the Standard Foundation programme will be awarded a scholarship if they achieved top results. The scholarship will be awarded at three levels depending on their final grades:

- \$5,000 NZD
- \$2,500 NZD
- \$1,000 NZD

### International Excellence Scholarships

Scholarships of up to \$5,000 are available for the Foundation programme. These scholarships are competitively assessed and only awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance in their previous studies.

### Fast-Track Scholarships

Successful applicants of the Fast-track Foundation programme are automatically granted a scholarship of \$2,500.

\*\*\*Non-central accommodation is within 40 minutes of the campus (including walking).

\*\*\*\*Only limited spaces available for Homestay Plus options due to high demand.

+Allows for homestays for students under 18 to be checked once per term to ensure the Education Code of Practice requirements are being met (a reduced fee may be payable by New Zealand citizens or permanent residents who are Under 18 and not living with a parent).

<sup>^</sup>Holiday break refers to any break that is more than seven days (six nights). Host families will provide lunches and cover additional utilities cost during the break and an extra \$30 per week will be charged.

# International students must have comprehensive medical and travel insurance while in New Zealand. Enrolled international students will be charged Allianz's Studentsafe Inbound Learners insurance premium when enrolment is completed. The final cost of insurance will depend on the length of requested insurance cover period.
