Scholarships

University of Tasmania International Pathway College Scholarships

Scholarships valued up to 20% of tuition fees are available for pathway programs. No application is required. Applicants are automatically assessed after submitting their application for an eligible course at UTASIPC. The scholarships are for all pathway applicants from all regions. Please reach out to admissions team for details on your eligibility or visit utas.up.education

Tasmanian International Scholarship (TIS)

The TIS provides commencing international students with a 25% reduction in registered tuition fees for the duration of their course (provided satisfactory grades are maintained). All international students who submit an application to study in an undergraduate degree (with the exception of the Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine, Bachelor of Dementia Care and AMC Seafaring courses) will be automatically assessed for the TIS Scholarship by our Admissions Team. This scholarship is also available to international students applying for postgraduate coursework degrees (with a few course exceptions). As students are assessed automatically for the TIS upon submission of their application, there is no need to apply separately, nor do recipients need to apply for ongoing eligibility.

Foundation Studies Program to Degree Scholarship

This scholarship provides international students who have completed the University's Foundation Studies Program (FSP) with a 10% tuition fee reduction in their undergraduate coursework program. The scholarship is available for all undergraduate programs (with the exception of the Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine degree). Applicants are automatically assessed after submitting their application for a FSP to Degree package. FSP graduates who are not successful in being awarded a TIS for their degree studies will still be entitled to this scholarship.
