PATHWAY SCHOLARSHIPS

Foundation Connect progression scholarship

Student who successfully progressed from Foundation Connect programme to Standard Foundation programme will be awarded a scholarship if they achieved top results. The scholarship will be awarded at three levels depending on their final grades:

- \$5.000
- \$2.500
- \$1.000

International Excellence Scholarships

Scholarships of up to NZ\$5,000 are available for the Foundation programme. These scholarships are competitively assessed and only awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance in their previous studies. If you are interested in applying, please enquire with your agent or Regional Representative about the next steps.

Fast Track Foundation Scholarship

Scholarships of up to NZ\$2,500 are available for the Foundation programme. These scholarships are competitively assessed and only awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance in their previous studies. If you are interested in applying, please enquire with your agent or Regional Representative about the next steps.

PROGRESSION SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships are exclusive to UP Foundation Studies students. They are awarded towards the tuition fees of the first year of undergraduate degree study at Victoria University of Wellington. Students will be assessed for these scholarships upon their completion of the programme, and each student can only receive one of the awards.

- NZ\$5,000 for a student with good academic grades who is involved in the extracurricular and community activities on offer by UP Education.
- NZ\$5000 for two students who have a grade point average 80-100%.
- NZ\$3000 for two students who have a grade point average 70-79%.
- NZ\$500 for any student at the school's discretion.

[^]Holiday break refers to any break that is more than seven days (six nights). Host families will provide lunches and cover additional utilities cost during the break and an extra \$30 per week will be charged.

[#]International students must have comprehensive medical and travel insurance while in New Zealand. Enrolled international students will be charged Allianz's Studentsafe Inbound Learners insurance premium when enrolment is completed. The final cost of insurance will depend on the length of requested insurance cover period.
