Option '

Seek employment after level 6 with an accredited employer in New Zealand

Most of the employers who offer our students paid internships are accredited employers and if successful you may have the option to work for up to 3 years on the Accredited Employer Workplace Visa.# Option 2

Seek employment after graduating from AUT Bachelor degree with any employer

According to the most recent update from Immigration New Zealand, students who gained a bachelor degree in New Zealand will be eligible to apply for a post study work visa for the same lenght of their study period.#

Terms and Conditions of the scholarship scheme:

- Scholarship applications open on the 12th of September 2022
- Students must commence their Level 5 course on or before the 31st of March 2023
- To apply for the scholarship the student (or their representative) must indicate on the application for that they wish to be considered for the Hospitality New Zealand Recovery Scholarship
- Successful applicants will be notified at the time of receiving their unconditional offer of place with the scholarship applied as a discount against their fees (\$3000 against the Level 5 course fees and \$2000 against the Level 6 course fees)
