2024 Pathway Scholarships

CDU International College offers a number of scholarships for international students who wish to study a pathway course in order to achieve their goal of studying at a world-class university.

Standard scholarship applies to all CDU International College programs and covers **up to 20%** of the tuition fee if students meet entry requirements.

Merit scholarship applies to Foundation Studies, First Year Diploma and Masters Qualifying Program (excluded ELICOS program) and covers **up to 30%** of the tuition fee based on Academic and English excellence.

- Foundation/Diploma – Applicant must display an overall credit average grade from high school and overall IELTS 6.0 or equivalent
- MQP – Applicant must display an overall credit average grade in previous degree and overall IELTS 6.5 or equivalent

No application is required. Applicants are automatically assessed after submitting their application for an eligible course.
