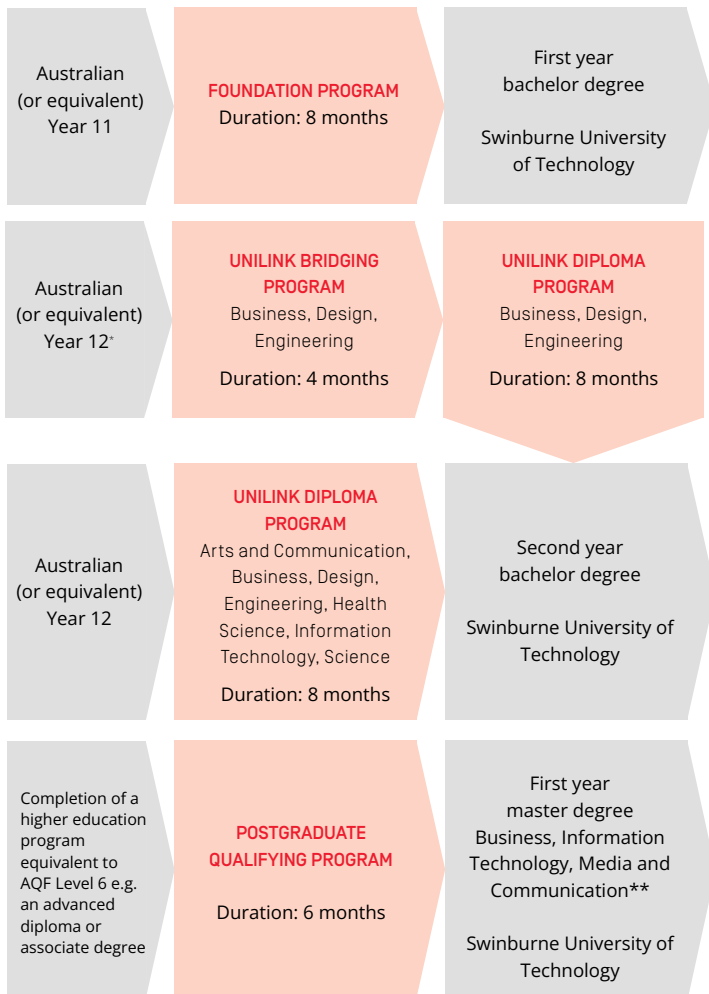

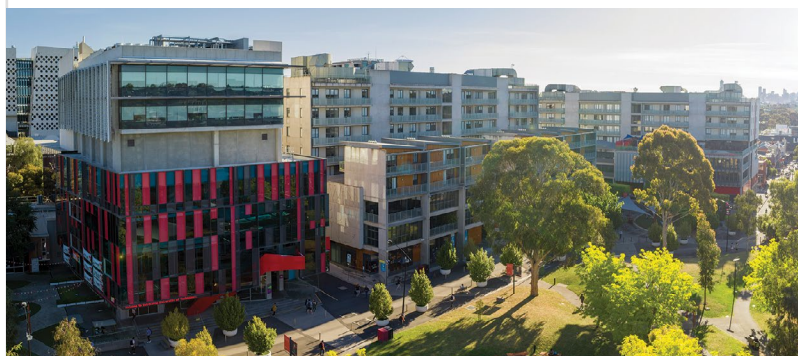

## International scholarships

### ELICOS+ Exclusive

Up to 10 weeks ELICOS tuition included in packaged programs, valued **up to A\$4800**. It refunds **up to 10 weeks** of your ELICOS English-language course tuition fees across the first three semesters of your Swinburne course.

### Swinburne College International Scholarship

**Up to 15%** off your tuition fees for the standard course duration. This scholarship is offered to international students commencing their studies in a Foundation Year, UniLink Bridging Program, UniLink diploma or Postgraduate Qualifying Program.

### Swinburne International Scholarship

**Up to 20%** off your tuition fees for the standard course duration. This scholarship is offered to international students commencing their studies at Swinburne. If eligible, you will receive the scholarship for the standard duration of your qualification with Swinburne.

### Other scholarships

If eligible, you can receive **up to 30%** off your tuition fees for the standard course duration with Ethel Swinburne Women in STEM International Scholarship or George Swinburne International Excellence Scholarship.
