ELICOS+ Exclusive

Up to 10 weeks ELICOS tuition included in packaged programs, valued **up to A\$4800**. It refunds **up to 10 weeks** of your ELICOS English-language course tuition fees across the first three semesters of your Swinburne course.

Swinburne College International Scholarship

With Glenferrie train station directly on campus, plus bustling Glenferrie Road on our doorstep, you'll soon fall in love with this place you'll call home.


