The cooler weather was a challenge initially. However, the ease of finding accommodation and the inclusive environment here made the transition smoother. Auckland's diversity and openness have made me feel welcomed and safe.

How have you adjusted to the social life at college?

It was lonely at first without fellow Indonesians around. But through group projects and socialising, I've formed friendships with students from diverse backgrounds, which has greatly enriched my experience.

It's important to engage and make connections. Don't hesitate to ask questions or initiate contact. Everyone is adjusting, and your proactive approach will help you settle in faster.
