## ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS

You must:

- Be aged from 14 to 16 years old
- Have English level: IELTS (Academic) score of 4.5 with no band score lower than 4.0, or equivalent
- Have completed:
  - » China: Completion of the last year of Junior High School.
  - » Rest of World: Completed the equivalent of New Zealand Year 10

## SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship is valued at **\$5,000 NZD** of the tuition fee for the students who apply and are accepted into the Victoria University of Wellington Pathways Link programme in the February intake of 2024.
