## Entry requirements



### Academic:

- ▶ Hold a bachelor degree or an approved equivalent qualification. *Note: Detailed academic entry criteria is determined by our admissions team.*

### English language competency:

- ▶ IELTS Academic 7.0 with no band lower than 7.0 or equivalent approved by the Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand and NZQA. Different band scores from multiple tests can be combined, conditions apply. [teachingcouncil.nz](http://teachingcouncil.nz) | [nzqa.govt.nz](http://nzqa.govt.nz).

### Other:

- ▶ Subject to satisfactory police checks, and referee report and interview. Required documents will be listed on conditional offer letter issued by admissions team.
