Academic:

University Entrance via either NCEA or CIE, overseas high school diploma or an approved equivalent qualification. Note: Detailed academic entry criteria is determined by our admissions team.

English language competency:

- Bachelor's or Master's degree for two or more years of full-time, face-to-face study while living in New Zealand, Australia, the USA, the UK, Canada, Ireland, or South Africa.
- ▶ IELTS Academic 7.0 with no band lower than 7.0, or PTE (A) 65 in each band, or equivalent as approved by the Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand and NZQA. Different band scores from multiple tests can be combined, conditions apply. teachingcouncil.nz | nzqa.govt.nz.

Subject to satisfactory police checks, and referee report and interview. Required documents will be listed on conditional offer letter issued by admissions team.
