1. Can you introduce yourself?

They are closely connected with real business roles such as business analysts, and also helpful for people with a background in finance or accounting.

Yes, my family is here with me. Because I'm studying a Master's programme, I was able to invite them to join me. My daughter now goes to primary school here on a student visa, which is great for her learning and for our family life. After graduation, I'll be eligible for a three-year Post Study Work Visa, which will give me a good chance to find a job in New Zealand.

I think things like data analysis, Excel, and using tools like MyCircle are very useful. My employer liked that I had experience with those tools. If you come from accounting or finance, adding informatics knowledge can really help you stand out.

9. What advice would you give to new international students?

First, prepare your English and be active in class. Don't be afraid to ask for help. Your teachers, classmates, and student support staff are all willing to help. Also, search online if you don't understand something. I believe self-study is very important here.

10. What are your future goals after graduation?

After graduating, I want to find a job in finance. I believe the skills I've learned at Yoobee and my part-time experience will really help. I also brought my family with me, and my daughter is now studying in primary school here. It's a good environment for both study and life.

Yes, I'm currently a student ambassador for Yoobee. I answer questions from new or potential students, mostly online through the website.
